



Research Assistant Position Announcement Speech and Signal Processing Laboratory

Graduate Research Assistantships are currently available in the Marquette University Speech and Signal Processing lab on projects in Computer-Aided Language Learning (CALL) and Computer-Aided Pronunciation Training (CAPT). This work, funded by the National Science Foundation, focuses on the development of speech technologies to estimate articulatory patterns from acoustics and use them to assess and correct pronunciation patterns. Related areas include acoustic-articulator inversion, pronunciation error classification, and articulatory synthesis.

Compensation includes tuition reimbursement as well as a monthly stipend of \$1800 per month. Candidates should have a Bachelors or Masters degree, with background related to speech and/or signal processing.
